Approval of Minutes

The September minutes were approved as recorded.

AASC Chair Expectations

One week prior to agenda setting, the AASC Chair will request agenda items from the faculty. The Chair will set the agenda with the Chief Academic Officer (CAO) and forward the agenda with accompanying items to AASC members as well as faculty at least one week prior to the scheduled meeting. The Chair will be in charge of facilitating the meeting by bringing forward each agenda item, guiding discussion, and tabulating votes. The Chair or designee will contact all individuals who have submitted agenda items regarding decisions made by the AASC. The Chair shall have served a minimum of one year on the AASC and upon being elected will serve a two year term.

Cut Scores

Dean Dahlen distributed a memo from the Office of the Chancellor identifying recommended minimum Accuplacer cut scores which would indicate a student is ready for introductory college level courses. These cut scores apply to a student who plans to begin taking courses in Fall 2008 at any Minnesota state college or university.

Dean proposed the following:

Reading comprehension – maintain the current cut score of 66 to determine if a student needs to take a developmental reading score for all program areas. Faculty determine which courses are reading intensive and apply the new MnSCU cut score of 78 to those courses. The current developmental reading courses need to be reviewed to determine if another reading course should be developed to address the different reading levels.

Sentence skills – stop administering the sentence skills section of the test. Students who attain a score of 78 on the Reading Comprehension will be placed into college level writing.

Math sequence -- maintain current cut score for developmental courses: MATH 0080, 0090, 0094, 0098. Follow MNSCU recommendations for access to MATH 1110 College Algebra and MATH 1102 Contemporary Math. Students who score 85 on Elementary Algebra but did not score above a 50 on CLM may still be allowed into College Level Math.

Jeff and Mike will schedule a meeting with faculty from the English and Math departments as well as Dean Dahlen to review and propose implementations within the next two weeks. Faculty need to determine what prerequisites should to be set for each course. All these changes must be entered in ISRS before the Academic Administrative Assistants can begin entering the Fall 08 schedule.

Course Survey

A faculty request was submitted wondering if the course survey could be conducted later in the semester instead of mid semester. The committee indicated the mid semester date was set by Shared Governance. Kathy will forward the request to shared governance.
