- Faculty will consult with Academic Deans regarding course proposals, ideas, changes, etc.
- 2. Faculty will develop the common course outlines and Curriculum Modification/Development Forms based on discipline/program faculty support, advisory board input where applicable and the Academic Dean.
- 3. It is strongly encourages that the faculty consult with their local AASC faculty in the development of learner outcomes.
- 4. Faculty will forward Common Course Outline and Curriculum Modification/Development Forms to the AASC Chair prior to submission deadlines,
- 5. The AASC Chair will forward the information to the AASC committee members.
- 6. The AASC members will review the information prior to the meeting.

7. AASC recommendations to approve or disapprove will be made the meeting and communicated to the faculty member via memo.
