#### **Background Study Policy**

A group developed a background study policy this summer. The draft policy distributed has been cleared by Office of General Council. The draft was approved and will be posted for the college community to review.

## Prerequisite change request

Faculty need to decide on a per course level whether or not the course prerequisite should include developmental courses (reading, writing, math). General courses (example: HLTH \_\_\_\_\_) that are core to programs or department(s) must have the input of those faculty as well.
