## <u>Curriculum Handbook – Next Gen Accuplacer -- FYEC course</u>

Brian indicated the curriculum handbook is still under review.

The Next Gen Accuplacer is in the process of being implemented at the college. The testing scores will be very different from the old system. Courses that refer to Accuplacer scores will need to be updated to remove software name and scores.

FYEC course will be reviewed this year. The data does not indicate one way or the other if requiring the course lead to benefits. Also considering implementing that once a student registers for the course, they cannot drop without advisor approval.

The Commit to Complete project received a thumbs up (Demonstrates Genuine Effort) from the HLC.

### Degree pathways in Associate of Arts

The system level Transfer Pathways project includes several within the AA degree. A couple of these may make sense for NCTC to adopt. When we do adopt an AA Transfer Pathway (System level), we will need to revisit NCTC's AA Pathways – and remove these NCTC level pathways as the combination of the system pathways with these will be too confusing for students and advisors.
