3340P ASSESSMENT FOR COURSE PLACEMENT PROCEDURE

Unless exempt by Policy 3340, all students are required to take the College Board ACCUPLACER test for assessment.

ACT, SAT, and MCA test scores are valid for a limited time of five (5) calendar years, inclusive of the current calendar year. Accuplacer scores are valid as outlined in the table below.

Students desiring to retake the ACCUPLACER test may do so at their discretion. If students are taking the ACCUPLACER after expiration, it will be treated as an initial test assessment. NCTC's procedure for initial attempts and retakes of the ACCUPLACER test are below. -The best valid score is used for placement.
