Advisory Committee Meeting
Accounting Career Programs
October 28, 2014
Minutes

Attendance: Tracy Boman, Marilynn Ogden, Karla Anderson, Jacki Cleveland, Briana Barclay, Jean Schmidt, Bobbie Pederson

Reports: Items brought forth to share with the committee were enrollment in the accounting program, current program offerings, and results of the spring 2012-2014 NOCTI examination.

- After Introductions the committee reviewed the minutes from the prior meeting.
- The committee reviewed the current program offerings in accounting.
- The committee reviewed enrollment in the accounting programs. Enrollment per the system is higher than actual student in class. Possible reasons are that students have changed majors but not declared in the system, or might be taking a few courses from our curriculum online.
- The NOTCT results were reviewed. The % earned by each class has dropped since 2012. Tracy Boman explained that she started tracking results in 2012. 2012 was an exceptional class with 2 of 6 students earning in the 90th percentile. The class of 2013 & 2014 percentages earned were 72.8% and 70% respectively. It was shown that taking out the 2 lowest scores for 2013 and 2014 the test average for both years was approximately 75%. This was shown to give the committee an idea of what the score should be with students that complete the degree in 2 years without having to take an accounting course twice. Tracy indicated that spring 2015 scores will be higher than the last 2 years.
- Tracy Boman shared with the committee that there will not be a spring meeting if there is no new business to conduct.
