Reports: Items brought forth to share with the committee were current program offerings, program

revision documents.

- After Introductions the committee reviewed the minutes from the prior meeting.
- All members were thanked for their continued support of our program.
- The following changes were brought forth to the committee. All items were discussed and approved.
 - Removal of 2 learner outcomes on estate planning and Non-profit accounting and the addition of one on tax research for ACCT 2210 Income Tax II. Estate taxes and non-profit are two extensive subjects beyond a 3-credit course.
 - Change one program learner outcome to remove coverage of non-profit and estate taxes.
 - Addition of Accounting Transfer Pathways degree. This degree allows for more accounting credits to be completed at Northland than what currently transfers.
 - Offer courses in the accounting program hi-flex. This allows for the option to take the courses online therefore increasing enrollment.
 - Add personal finance as option to take instead of Macro Economics.
 - o Align semester sequence between campuses.
 - Removal of ACCT 2204 Intermediate Accounting as a prerequisite to Accounting Capstone course. Add BUSN 2222 Principles of Accounting II, ACCT 1104 Payroll. This allows for greater flexibility to offer less credit degree offerings in the future.
- The committee discussed that a spring meeting would be held only if there was new business to discuss.
