**Minutes:**

- Addressing old business – a discussion was held around the Grand Forks Career Impact Academy and the opportunity that might lead to future Northland students. Trevor brought up Moorhead High Schools Career Academy. This lead into more discussion on outreach and recruiting directly at high schools in the region. Rod and Erin will be reaching out to more high schools this year. Northland has also started a STEAM experience option that hosts K-12 students, or any prospective student, on campus for a variety of activities. This should be running by the end of the month and will hopefully give students a good hands-on experience of the program.
- Current enrollment is reflecting the national downward trend. Administration is looking for other delivery methods and the ARCH dept will investigate our regional competition to see what is being offered and what might be attractive for future Northland students. One thought is to market our 31 credit Intro Diploma to Carpentry students for a Design/Build type of skill set.
- With Rod's upcoming retirement there may be some restructuring of classes within the program. Credit content should not change as there are three transfer agreements in place for the AAS.
