Minutes:

- Introduction of attendees. Trevor Anderson has stepped down from the Advisory Board.
- Enrollment is looking better with first years. Ten students started at the beginning of the semester, one being a Post-Secondary Education Option (PSEO) student from EGF and one being a returning student. One student withdrew from the program with plans to return after dealing with family issues. We have four students joining in the spring where they can take Model Construction and Environmental Design as there are no prerequisites for those classes. Outreach efforts this semester have included attending the Northern Valley Career Expo as in previous years. We also hosted a group of high school trades students from Central (Red River was unable to attend) and EGF will be visiting in early December. Northland recently hired a new recruiter to fill an open position from over the summer, so that person is getting oriented and up to speed. We continue to look for opportunities to promote our program.
- Along those lines, Erin is in the early stages of developing an Online College in the High School (OCHS) course for CAD I, which is a 5 credit first-year class, covering the basics of AutoCAD. This would hopefully encourage high school students to pursue the Architectural Technology program.
- The schedule has been adjusted for Model Construction and Environmental Design to run as 8
 week courses instead of 16 week courses. The credit load remains the same and students will
 complete work outside of the scheduled course hours. This model seems to be popular with
