Roger reported that NCTC is currently in the process of NCA accreditation.

Currently Auto Body offers 60 credits for four semesters with an additional 5 credits of required Life Skills. This may change pending results of a bill in the legislature with requirements for occupational programs. The conversion of quarters to semesters has gone well for both instructors.

Ken reported on enrollment with only two part-time students and two PSEO students. There are 19 full time students. Placement for '98 graduates was at 100%. There are fewer calls for '99 graduates than last year. Two students are currently on internship Auto Body sent three students to VICA competition in March.

A tour was given of both shop areas. Equipment is maintained with the amount of funds we are allocated. Some replacement of tools has been done. A motion was made by Chuck Hoard to continue working to receive air make-up units for both shops. Motion seconded by Gene Henrickson. Motion carried. They felt now would be a good time to do this at a considerable savings when the college is replacing the roof this summer.
