PROGRAM UPDATES

Minneapolis - George Hoxie student enrollment is approx 18, with 2 instructors and one lab assistant; have added 4 new certificates to existing degree options

Northland - Bob Wold student enrollment is approx 40, with 5 instructors; graduate placement continues to be strong; Northland will have a new president next year

Southeast Tech - Tim VanLoon student enrollment is approx 18 with 2 instructors; new credit loads in diploma and degree programs; noted effects of recent media reports

Metro State University - Kim Dobbert approximately 125 students currently in Aviation Management program; primarily adult learners, but now beginning to see younger students

INDUSTRY UPDATES

MRO - Jeff Buzzell operators such as Regent are busy; WipAire is very busy and has recently hired additional maintenance personnel

Corporate - Mike Murphy 2004 was a turnaround year for bizjets; numbers and projections are up for Citation, Gulfstream, Bombardier and Honeywell; local corporate operators such as 3M and General Dynamics are doing well; Cargill flights are up

Regional - Carla Stark and Beau Curtis Pinnacle has hired 14 maintenance personnel at MSP since 02/23/04; currently have openings at several other locations; always willing to talk to students

MATA - George Bolon as MNSCU institutions shift toward the profit/loss model, we will see fewer students but better graduates; Tim and Beau noted pressures which work to reduce total numbers of aircraft maintenance personnel long-term

Major (NWA) - David Dyrud currently training contract maintenance providers; significant pressures to reduce labor costs; Jerry England retired, but was not replaced

FAA effective date of FAR 145.163 has been delayed until 04/06/06

STATEWIDE AVIATION ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS - Janese Thatcher
MNDOT/Aero continues to represent programs at events such as airport open
houses and high school visits; current projects include an articulation
agreement between MN high schools and MNSCU aviation programs; identifies
6 courses: Air Transportation, Aerodynamics and Flight, Aviation Physics,
Aircraft Charts and Drawings, Aircraft Weight and Balance, and Intro to Air
Traffic Control; articulation agreement includes required curriculum content
and defines procedures for student transition to post-secondary institution;
also consistent with Governors current initiative; discussion revealed support
from committee, and suggested that internships also be available
