Program Requirements	All	All courses are valuable for students in the field. Financial aid will only cover classes in program. Options: List early childhood classes in curriculum and a list of courses students can choose as electives that matches their personal educational needs. Some electives have different learner outcomes and will not be counted in the current curriculum. NCTC ILO's The Advisory Board agrees that to allow options for electives that have been pre-determined so that the classes meet basic requirements of the college. (Comp1, Small Group Comm and Interper Comm are classes to consider as well as making recommendations as an advisory board.) The ability to have a more customized curriculum is important to the students as it will give them more flexibility. The advisory team requests that Peggy look at other college courses. A 16 credit certificate was discussed. The board recommends that Peggy investigate creating a 16 credit certificate for NCTC.
