  - a. We had a one year program in Staples, Minnesota which will be completed in December 2004.

  - c. We have added a part time program in EGF and our first full time program will be offered in EGF fall 2005. We accepted 36 students for spring semester 2005 and will accept another 24 students for fall semester 2005.
  - d. We have added a part time program in Bemidji beginning spring semester 2005. We accepted 24 students in the spring start.

- 6. Updates on PN nursing program in TRF: 60 started fall semester and 45 started spring semester. 30 to 60 graduate per year. Our Roseau cohorts graduate December 2004.
