The percentage is most likely higher, but we can't find all grads and don't hear from all of them.  Program completion rate: Outcome: 84% completion.  Retention/completion rates for spring '19 - fall '19 was 84% total.  No spring start cohort in TRF; 90% EGF; 74% DE/Hybrid. Goal met.  Satisfaction surveys:  • Grad exit survey: Outcome: 90% of grads will agree or strongly agree that they're satisfied with program effectiveness. This has been met last 2 years. Fall '19 results: 98% (51/52) of respondents' rate this question agree or strongly agree.
