Report from Program Director Program Demographics	 Average score on the NPTE has increased every year of the program. The program's next accreditation self-study report is due early September 2013, with the accreditation on-site visit scheduled for Novemberr 2013. Justin is planning on taking a sabbatical this spring to increase his time to work on the self study report. Faculty Activities: Justin completed training to be a CAPTE on-site visitor for accredication on-site visits and will be presenting two research studies at CSM 2013. Shelley will be co-teaching a CI-credentialing course this winter Jamestown college is starting a DPT Program in Fargo. We are unsure how this will effect clinical site availability.
