1. Call to Order	Meeting was called to order at 6:41 PM
2. Review of prior meeting minutes	Minutes were reviewed, no changes recommended
3. Introductions	Introductions on new members occurred
4. Report from Program Director & Program Demographics/Outcomes	<p>1. Program Demographics: Mean Scores for NPTE are going well, but program has lowest 1st time pass rate in 4 years (86.7% ultimate; 2 year average: 92.8%). Good applicant pool, 7 students accepted so far for next year</p> <p>2. Admission requirement change: Program would like to increase minimum TEAS V for AH score from 50-58%. Analysis regarding this change was discussed regarding past student outcomes. Advisory committee members agreed with the change.</p> <p>3. Two Developing PTA Programs in Minneapolis may impact clinical sites, Rasmussen College & Herzing University have both hired program directors and are planning on submitting an Application for Candidacy to CAPTE.</p> <p>4. St. Paul College is also considering starting a PTA program, with NCTC sending a</p>

	<p>letter opposed. Alexandria Tech is also interested, with NCTC also opposed to that as well due to availability of clinical sites and employment</p> <p>5. APTA CSM 2017. For the 4th year in a row NCTC students will present research at CSM</p> <p>6. Collaboration with UND DPT Program. Expanded neuro project going well (Shelley Explain). 1st year students will be meeting with first year DPT students on case studies this fall</p> <p>7. Faculty activities: Shelley: GFPS Medical Careers Advisory Board; Dawn: Is teaching kinesiology for OTA; Justin: Expected to graduate with PhD in Higher Education in December, defends dissertation in November</p>
5. Accreditation Update	The program needs to make minor revisions to curriculum Justin and Shelley will be attending self-study workshop at CSM 2017.
6. Report from Program ACCE	Total of 63 contracts involving 165 clinical sites. Total clinical positions available: 367. Total outpatient positions: 214. Total inpatient positions: 153.
7. Committee Constitution review	No changes were recommended to the constitution.
8. Membership representation review	Representation reviewed. Will look at again in spring with 3 committee members completing their term
