	Program Effectiveness Data- annual update	The pass rate and scores for the Class of 2020 were reviewed and analyzed. Class of 2019 scores and pass rates were used for comparison.  Equipment operations and QA continue to be a lower scoring category, along with the Thorax and Abd section  It was agreed that the COVID-19 pandemic played a vital role in some unsuccessful attempts for some students. (3 students did not pass on the first attempt)  • Test Centers delayed openings for testing availability in a timely manner immediately following graduation  • Registry Prep had to finish online with just a general overview, not focused to students needs and struggles, as they weren't expressed like in a classroom setting  • Stresses of the situation and future		

Northland's Program Sustainability Data Analysis review	The FY2019 data the college uses to analyze individual programs was reviewed by the committee. The Radiology program is in the "green" at 5/7. It was discussed that a 7 is almost impossible with the financial analysis tool used and the student FYE to faculty FTE for running our program. We will see where 1 less faculty puts us next year. Green is a good standing for a program.  The program is very sustainable as it has been in the green since analysis of programs started many years ago at Northland Community and Technical College.  Program Cost Analysis Tool and Student FYE to Faculty FTE were the 2 negative sections on the data analysis form. 5/7 is a green score.  It was noted by Beland that there were 3 faculty (2 full-time and 1 adjunct for FYE 2019)  With a college goal of 17 to 1 for a benchmark, that goal will never be attainable for our program of 16 in each full co-hort This is not a concern as we are still in the green with 5 out of 7, which demonstrates sustainability.
Clinical updates	King updated the advisory board that we have lost 1 1 <sup>st</sup> year student due to personal reasons for dropping the program. Still have 16 in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> year co-hort.  2 new clinics entering the area (in Grand Forks), King, as clinical coordinator has already been in contact with these opportunities and will continue to monitor if they will make a good fit for our program (patient numbers, types of exams, etc)  Riverview's new facility is up and running!  COVID continues to be struggles for departments and program alike.
Rad Tech Week	Both Rad Tech clubs are participating in Rad Tech Week events next week: posters in the commons and potentially a shared gaming event for Northland students/faculty/staff to participate in.
ACERT Conference	Funds have been raised Conference is now virtual; students are working on a plan to still have fun while participating.

	Application process	The application process for the incoming Class of 2023 has started, November 1 <sup>st</sup> – Feb 1 <sup>st</sup> .  It was acknowledged that the Intro to Rad Tech and Patient Care course remains full every year. This is a plus to see continued interest in the program. It is not a requirement to complete prior to program entrance, but it is a course that allows points for program qualification and so many students do participate prior to enrollment in the program. There are 3 students in the 1 <sup>st</sup> year cohort, however, in this semesters course.
