Program Updates	Beland	 Addition of Clover Learning Platform/Rad Tech Book Camp (RTBC) Students will be required to purchase for their full 2nd year in the program – extremely beneficial for Registry Prep course, but Beland wants to utilize it for Imaging Equipment/QA Course also Class of 2020 didn't utilize – had low 1st attempt pass rate Class of 2021 club purchases for all students as they were unable to attend ACERT conference – 100% 1st attempt pass rate Class of 2022, not required but all but 2 purchased on their own Offers instructors to create their own exams based on student needs Offers audio/visual learning opportunities Saves student about 50% cost if created into an academic plan/program utilizes May utilize in placement of Image Critique and Image Production exams given during Registry Prep Course – Beland wants to wait to change exams until 2024 for evaluating how Class of 2023 works with the platform New Textbook Options for Physics are being reviewed – potentially a connection to RTBC instead?
