Program Assessment Data - Reviewed Annually	Beland	Annual Update – Class of 2022 Document Met items discussion: Reflected in both Clinical V rotation evaluations and Employer Surveys, graduates continue to strive in effective communication strategies Beland reflected on the fact that the program utilizes multiple different sites requiring students to establish communication needs early and they build on them throughout the program thank you to our clinical sites for supporting this growth Beland also stated the program formatting of clinical curriculum throughout the program supports the communication progression

	 Sara Riskey suggested focus on Radiologist communications – program to look into student sitting with the Radiologist for a ½ day
Beland and Tull	o Professionalism: Reg Prep Portfolio holds steady at 92% with a goal of average of 90% or > Goal setting throughout the program prompts professional structure Beland supported resume and cover letter formatting, and CEU and CQR sections prior to submissions for Class of 2023, but there were still weaknesses in their projects (just finished correcting this year's) Ryan Hager indicated importance of "keyword" correlation for resumes for job position and job description correlation, esp important for those students applying to larger facilities Clinically Competent Goal: Noted only 4 employees completed surveys – seeking much needed participation for accurate assessment practices Aiming to improve survey completion Problem Solving and Critically Thinking: Critically Thinking Procedures II change – Class of 2024 -results of change will not be reported until Spring 2025 Beland shared that King reported documentations demonstrates the Class of 2023 with an average of 87% (goal 90% average) Will be discussed more Spring 2024 Also reported by King were struggles with foundational exam requirement errors and lack of communication of basic order of procedures for the case studies' trauma pt. Tull is creating a new approach for the Critical Thinking Assessment, project in its infancy stages Unmet item discussion: 1 Unmet SLO in peach on the attached document reviewed RADT2240 – Reg. Prep Comprehensive Exam – Image Critique Exam Trend Tracking shared and discussed Beland recommended to switch to a RTBC examination format – 75 Procedures questions in the 3 ARRT Content Specifications Categories –Board approved of change
	 Continue Trend Tracking Potential follow up—upon assessment of new RTBC approach, if still unmet, distribute the old exam for comparison

Northland's		 Noted was a need for proactive changes as the Class of 2023 just completed this assessment and it will be unmet for review next year= 8/12 students fell below the goal of >77% with an average of 75.22% Those are worrisome results Image Critique Exam change to RTBC assessment Positives: Clover Learning updates and adjusts questions frequently Negatives: Faculty cannot monitor what questions were assigned; students will all have different sets of questions as they are pulled at random for a test bank, students cannot review missed questions nor can the instructor No new report available from 2022 data yet
