Program Effectiveness Data -Annual Update	Beland	 Pass Rate/Scores Analysis of Class of 2023 5 extremely low scaled scores – 2 didn't pass on first attempt 83% pass rate – no less than 80% is the program goal

		 Compared scaled scores with Class of 2022 where 100% past the first attempt Class of 2023 lowest categories 8.0 in both Radiation Physics and Radiobiology and Extremity Procedures (Class of 2022's was also Radiation Physics and Radiobiology with a 7.7, so 8.0 is an improvement) Class of 2023 highest category: 8.4 in Image Acquisition and Evaluation (Class of 2022's was 8.7 in Radiation Protection) National 5 year averages (2018 – 2022) were compared Employment Rates: 100% Program Completion Rates: Retention rates are calculated differently for the college vs. the JRCERT JRCERT doesn't require personal reasons for leaving the program as retention issues, the college does Retention data shared with the board 5 year retention rate for the JRCERT is 69 of 73; 94.5% (2019 – 2023)
Supervision Policy Review - Annually	Tull	Supervision policy reviewed by advisory members Tull explained the new implementation of the Trajecsys "evaluation" for clinical staff supervision review to be completed annually - This tracking system also for easier access and compliance of technologists
Change in SLO#5 Calculations	Tull	Clinical V – Critical Thinking Performance Evaluations calculations to point sum as this is how other assessments are calculated for accuracy and equivalency - Used to be a %, now scale of 1-4 - Program benchmark: Sum point averages of 2.7 or >
Action Plan Review	Tull and Beland	New action plan implemented for Rad Bio/Protection Project as it is newly unmet • First class to have this unmet – goal: 100% of students will score 90% or higher - Class Averages: 2023 – 84% 2022 – 97% 2021 – 98% 2020 – 98.75% 2019 97.5% • Lack of efforts in projects is noted – submission lengths and depths were not appropriate even with requirements laid out in the rubric and instructions • Team work was lacking on all projects – also a focus of the project that was missed for this cohort – reflects overall assessment of some of the Class of 2023 • Rubric will be restructured for Class of 2024 to use this spring

Northland Bonding Project	Beland	 300's south wing of EGF campus undergoing bonding project 1 semester's worth of construction (hopefully) Lab and hopefully addition of a program classroom are part of the Dec 2024-Aug 2025 bonding project Requested our lab to be intact during construction for use; program requires an energized lab for accreditation, at all times
Clinical Updates	Tull	 Ortho rotation change Lengthened rotation for ortho after student evaluations requested more quality time here Used to be a part of the SOF rotation, now it is RSC and Ortho is a rotation by itself and FMC is mixed in with the South and FMR rotation for Altru Clinic Rotations Implemented for the Class of 2025 and moving forward Disaffiliation of Essentia – Fargo Clinical Location was shared
