Faculty and graduates will line up downstairs of Chester Fritz: all have been asked to arrive to Chester Fritz at 10:30 am Recession: The mace carrier will lead the recession line to outside Chester Fritz (to the reception area). Chester Fritz will be asked to rope off the way out from the door to the stairways. By doing this it will be easier to follow the lead to outside Chester Fritz. Ben Hunter (usher) will stand at the mezzanine to open the rope to the nursing students when they arrive to the mezzanine and to also close the rope when the last nursing student passes by. Renee Kringlen will also guide the nursing students to go out of the recession line and then to go
