2. Bookstore Services	Brian Huschle	Karla to attend the next liberal arts meeting to discuss the buying and selling back of books.
3. Test Proctoring	Kent Hanson	Jim Davis does not want the library involved with test proctoring any longer. Ellen discussed – handout: Distance test proctoring – major time commitment. It was decided to form a task force to come up with a solution to this issue.

8. "House" Higher Ed Bonding Tour	Kent Hanson	The tour will be October 6, 2005. Folks with the most knowledge of particular areas need to be involved with the tour. Kent would like projectors set up in the areas of the proposals to show the area, where it is, and folks with knowledge will discuss it. Health care will be the major focus.
