2. Marketing Update	Lindsey	Lindsey has a Media schedule spreadsheet for spring and will email it to the team.
		Lindsey stated that we are planning an Allied Health Expo Day in late January or early February.
		The Trades dept. is also planning another Expo.
		The next plan is to schedule a Business Division Expo Day. Mike suggested that high schools bring their business organization testing here to our campus. If we can't be a testing site, make up our own event, bring in high schools and give trophies, etc.
3. Beth's Comments		Beth said that a college in Montana had a fundraiser for United Way in the form of an auction. Employees could purchase items on the auction through a payroll deduction. She said that by doing the payroll deductions high amounts were paid. Beth thought maybe we could do something like that for our Foundation.
4. ATM	Mike	Mike stated that it is illegal for us to own/operate an ATM machine with state funds. Mike said
