Approval of Minutes	Becky	Approved by committee after this correction. Topic: Lockdown Drill, 2. Answer should read "Majority of maintenance employees & all administration have been trained on the system."
2. First Report of Injury	Becky	 Injury of an IT employee occurred while moving a scanner/bulky piece of equipment, during an office move. Equipment was slipping out of hands so individual twisted body incorrectly. Employee did seek medical (chiropractic) care for lower back pain. A wheel based ergonomic/waist high cart was recommended by our committee to use during office moves when employees are eager to help. Faculty left shoulder problems from carrying laptop over the past 27 years, including numbness, carpel tunnel in both wrists. Employee did seek medical attention. A wheel based laptop carrier could be an option and possible sold out of our Bookstore. Becky will ask Karla if this could be arranged. At the January in-service we should bring in knowledgeable (Brown Bag) sessions provided by Shelly or DOER for employees.

5. State Safety Conference	Jesse	Jesse Adkins attended day two of his First Annual State Safety Fall Conference. Due to another commitment, he was not able to attend the first day which had the pertinent safety and workers compensation topics. The conference was well represented across the state. Some topics from day two included: Ergonomics, overindulging efforts; Adding value to Safety Committees-being proactive, getting a certain amount done and function well. EGF is on the right track but more could still be done. Jesse recommended that the committee possibly meet year-round to keep moving on ideas. The Regional Safety meeting is scheduled for the Spring which Becky attends.
6. Other: Safety and Training Coordinator	Becky	Becky will ask Administration to hire a three fourths time Safety and Training Coordinator with benefits for FY09. Smaller FYE campuses have hired full time coordinators so it is time we had someone committed only to safety and training.
