5. Quality Matters Update & Discussion	Beth M., Dorinda S., Karen Z. Mary A. 15 minutes	<p>NCTC as an institution is falling behind in having faculty participate in QM faculty development activities. Sub group meant a few weeks ago, and discussed that it's a struggle to encourage faculty participation. We can't force faculty members to participate. The IYOC is a good review for faculty who have been teaching online for quite a long time. Need to find the 'right reason' to have faculty look at their course. Selling point may be 'saving yourself time' by incorporating course design improvement. Peer to peer may be best way to recruit. How do we talk about making courses more accessible, improving course design? Need to talk to those who have taken courses previously but now haven't done any more. Takes a culture shift to start talking about best practices! Faculty perceive themselves as being better at technology than they actually are (survey data shows this). MnSCU 2 & 4 year colleges' survey data also shows that departments do not support faculty development. /Brian and Mary to follow up to see if there is time at Jan. in-service for 3-4 hour block for a technology fair (2 hours minimum).</p>
