Call to order		
1. Review Minutes & Agenda	Tina M.	Minutes of the previous meeting held 11-09-16 were approved with changes.
2. Online Student Success tool	Brian H.	No update at this time.
3. Strategic Agenda	Tina M.	Faculty Development Coordinators Peggy R. and Dorinda scheduled training sessions on the subject of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) entitled "ABC's of Designing Accessible Documents." This training was scheduled Dec 5 and 6 for both campuses via video conference. The 6 Dec session was cancelled due to campus closure for inclement weather. Sherry Lindquist led the training 5 Dec. Four or five individuals attended the 5 Dec session on each campus; primarily staff members attended. Following discussion, it was decided to repeat the training after the holidays and perhaps add it to the faculty in-service in January. Brian will coordinate to determine whether it can be added to the in-service. It was also agreed that another session for staff should be held after the first two weeks of January.
4. Replacements/additions to ProctorU and Respondus	Tina M.	Committee discussed whether to consider other options to Proctor U. Proctor U actually provides a person whereas other programs do not and are automated. Proctor U has been receptive to questions in the past. Beth suggested compiling a list of concerns or questions for Proctor U and contacting them for a response. 5. CATT	Tina M.	Beth attended the CATT meeting last week. Items discussed at the meeting included moving D2L to the cloud, future professional development opportunities, on-going fundraising opportunities, and an update on captioning with Kaltura. CATT will make a recommendation to the Tech Council at their meeting next week to move D2L to the cloud. Grants for up to \$25K are available to support OER resources; sharktank \$25K grants are also available.
