## The ECAR SS18 Results Summary

The ECAR survey gave us some basic information about our student body. A third of our students were independent with their own dependents, and about another third were independent but without dependents. Over 70% of our students held jobs other than work study jobs while enrolled in our classes. Nearly 2/3 of our students were independent, working adults, and almost ¾ identified as female.

Overall our students say they are having excellent overall experiences with technology at Northland Community and Technical College (NCTC) as compared to the system or Minnesota colleges.

These experiences include the Wi-Fi in our classrooms/instructional spaces and campus libraries and even the institutional login. More of Northland's student rate these as excellent than students in any other category. The extremely low percentages for the system and Minnesota colleges for the classroom/instructional spaces question is puzzling. In spite of Northland's higher numbers than other groups of institutions, there is still room for improvement.

Northland's Institutional Online Success Tools have been used by the majority of our students, but with mixed results. For students, the guidance toward future courses, the early alert system, and the performance improvement help were very or extremely useful. Other tools however, such as those that suggested new/different academic resources, degree mapping or planning tools and tools showing when degree requirements were completed were less useful to Northland's students. Whether Northland was rated more highly than other categories of institutions, there is still room to improve our institutional online tools to make them more useful to our students.
