| 2. Quality<br>Improvement<br>Process (QIP) | Mike                 | OLC: courses for first time online teachers QIP is a self-reflective study. There are no metrics on which the college will be graded. Updates on the justification narrative for the tuition difference between on-campus and online courses, due November 19, by Brian, Jodi, Shannon J., Mike C.: \$165/credit but \$199/credit (additional \$34) for online credits. We have 15,000+ credits to account for as our share of online credits from the consortium with Alex Tech and NW Tech. Some reasons for the cost disparity: -D2L support costs -Classroom caps are lower for many classes (48 in biology on land, 30 online for example) -Proctoring costs -Additional software (Camtasia, SoftChalk, etc.) Parity between per credit classes and online credits can be reached by 2021/22 with effort. Section B is the faculty support piece of the QIP and is due in March. Section C is due in May. |
