2. HyFlex Classroom/Zoom Huddle Rooms	Shamani/Angie	The quote was submitted. The vendor needs to complete MN State Vendor approval process. Unsure if this will be ready by fall semester. Need clarification if this would work for instructors who are Zooming into classes from their home offices.
3. D2L Course Creation & Enrollment, Quizzes Updates	Karleen	D2L course creation and enrollments.  D2L has integrated the new course creation and enrollment process. As instructors may have noticed, if an instructor is enrolled in a course, the course appears in D2L through Spring 2023 semester. However, for this next year (Summer 22, Fall 22, Spring 2023), student enrollments will follow the old 55 days before semester start process. Which means, Summer 22 students have met the 55-day requirement and will be enrolled / dropped every 15 minutes. Fall 22 students will start processing around July 1st. Spring 23 students will start processing around November 15, 2022. Any semesters thereafter, instructors and students will appear in the D2L course 15 minutes after enrollment.  Quizzes changes.  D2L has announced the Quizzes tool creation interface is in the process of being redesigned to resemble the Assignment tool. They are hoping to have the redesign ready by June 2022. The next 12 months will provide the Opt-In feature to give instructors the opportunity to try the redesigned interface and provide feedback. Then making the new interface permanent by July 2023. A couple features mentioned being looked into is the timing (login duration and length of time allowed to complete the quiz) and instructor ability to print. A process has begun to look into HP5 interactive quiz questions but will not be available by June. I will continue to send out information on timelines as it becomes available.
