## MINUTES

Topic	Responsible Party	Discussion/Outcome
1. FY08 Budget	Dennis Paesler	Dennis presented a summary of budget assumptions for FY08, including various tuition increases from 1-4%, and a projected deficit of \$307,685. He reported that the FY07 budget balance is looking better. Discussion was held on various long-range ideas to reduce expenditures college-wide for FY09 and beyond. President Temte proposed that the college work toward reducing the FY09 budget by 5% (approx \$1.25 million, or increase revenue to offset more costs). This would enable the college to balance the budget and have funding to invest in quality and continuous improvement. Discussion was held on meeting with area legislators and community leaders in late June to address the concerns for future funding, decreased high school populations, and ask for their ideas on how we can generate more revenue, etc. Cost analysis of various college services will be examined.
