#### Old Business:

- How to best utilize both campuses. Perhaps it would be wise to have the Drafting Dept and Construction Electricity move to EGF campus and become the Building Industry Center, and Auto Service move to TRF campus and become the Transportation Center.
- •The board wants to know if the Community knows what is going on. If they did they might be able to do a lot to help.
- Suggested that a lot of high schools now have what they call Career Days, and we should check into this.
- •Create a Facebook account, where there would be pictures of past graduates at their work place, with a testimonial from the student and their employer. Prospective students would be able to click a link on our web page that takes them to the Facebook page.
