- Lead discussions (War in Iraq)
- Specific availability within topics may vary; there is a good chance that we may be able to....
- Newly formed, but topics are expanding; -topics are continually changing and being updated.
- Affirmative action phrase to be made smaller
- Are you looking for an expert in a specific field, or someone involved in specific activities?

Speaking Topics: Topic list will be changing as new members come on board. It is understood that the initial draft of the flyer will be altered as the Speaker's Bureau develops.
