1. Welcome		Avis	Minutes of November 15 approved. (Dennis Wierima's spelling of last name corrected.)
Program     Outcome:		Committee	Who reviews the Program Learner Outcomes? Kerry will visit with David, and Jeff will visit with Kent.
3. Assessmo	ent Plan	Committee	Avis presented the latest draft of the merged Assessment Plan.  Pages 1-6 and appendix are new.  Page 5, part 3: Universal Goals – Kerry stated that these came from the technical college's program review plan. Jeff suggested these be dropped from the Assessment and Program Review Plan.  Kerry suggested changing Universal Goals Outcomes to Measurer of Learner Outcomes. Jeff added that the language in the second paragraph be changed, rather than eliminated. Committee agreed to replace the second paragraph (three statements) with simple college mission statement.  Jeff said to keep the measure of outcomes.  Avis review ed with the committee the appendix that she and Dorinda put together. Committee agreed to eliminate NCTC Institutional Learner Outcomes and replace with PROGRAM Learner Outcomes:  Avis will send out electronically the latest draft of Assessment Plan with Program Review.

APR committee will present between 9:30-10:15 a.m. at January 4 <sup>th</sup> in-service.  Kerry suggested a plea to faculty on the 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> that APR committee needs some time of response from – HELP US to eliminate repetition. Data must be colleted. Administration might

		be the proper personnel to request the plea. Administration may need to assign review dates to programs. Avis suggested acknowledging the programs who have graciously offered their program to be assessed.  Committee needs to hear both positive and negative feedback from those instructors who are currently conducting program reviews, in order to work on a better process.  Jeff suggested that Kerry talk with Division Chairs about presenting their review process to other faculty members.  Kerry will give a quick overview of what the APR committee has done to date. Key people report on their accomplishments. Kerry will give a plea to others to proceed with their own program assessment plan.  Kerry asked Tim Reuter to share with faculty the Auto Body Program's success and frustrations.
5. Program Review Workshop	Committee	February 24 <sup>th</sup> In-Service – Proposed that the Assessment Committee organize a program review workshop. Avis suggested a systematic presentation on the program review plan. Tim talked about Andy Mueller's assistance with critical thinking in reviewing common course outlines, explaining that course descriptions must be written for those who know nothing about the program itself.
