		Graduation rate discussed. Completion of program recognized by MnSCU. Some students leave prior to completion of programs (i.e. Welding students omit liberal arts courses because they land job as welder, meeting their personal goal.)

		B. Employer Survey online pilot – Al will talk with Chad to see if he can research approximately 5 survey sites, and possibly get a test-run going for spring semester. The Welding program will be the trial run of employer surveys.
