Minutes

- 1) Global and Civic and Responsibility Rubric still in progress, Brian H. and Mike will work on it after the meeting, along with Jeff and Cassie. Changes will be sent to Brian S. and Gabe who will also be working on the rubric.
- 2) Peggy went through the programs and mapped them to determine how they were assessing the ILO's . Now have a working document, but may not be doing a great job of assessing. Not all programs have identified what courses are addressing ILO's. Has only done it for AAS degrees, but Peggy will go back and do it for Diploma and Certificate programs.

For example, in Aerospace there isn't a course identified for Critical Thinking. Need to find program courses that were identified to assess ILO's. Jeff will go through in add in information for what was reported in the past so that we know which programs assessed which courses. Jeff will send out the updated list by the end of the week.

Carey asked if we will doing something similar for program reviews. Brian stated that we already have a mapping document that was produced when we reworked the program review reporting document.

- 3) Program Assessment, Karl has the list of what programs still haven't turned in their program assessments.
