A	 2. New Proposal Requests: a. Streamline Test Out/CPL Process – Julie Roisland b. Global Military Learning Network – Dorinda Sorvig c. CTE Nomenclature 2nd Review – ADawn Nelson 	a. Streamline Test Out/CPL Process: Concerns brought forward that the steps in the form are often not followed, which can leave students in a problematic situation if they have already taken a test out and turns out to not be eligible for one. Another concern is that students are being significantly undercharged compared to the costs of a test out to Northland (e.g. student charged \$50 but faculty paid \$75). Sarah Dorn let us know that the system office uses MyCPL, which is streamlined and ready for us to use. RESOLUTION: Learning Council unanimously recommends that the President implements MyCPL and we begin training faculty and staff on how to use it. Until MyCPL is live, we minimally edit the current form to ensure the Registrar signs off before charging a student. b. Global Military Learning Network: This is not a new program but reconfiguring our current options to better serve veterans. A small group worked to streamline Northland's AA degree specifically to create a bridge into liberal arts for our veterans. Alex Tech and others are currently doing a bridge programs. Unlike Alex's model, the committee recommended to Learning Council that Northland waives Goal Area 9 (ethical and civic responsibility) for veterans who provide proof of military service. Alex is proscriptive about which courses veterans can take to fulfill Goal Area 9 whereas Northland would waive it. RESOLUTION: Learning Council unanimously recommends that the President support the bridge program and move it forward to AASC for implementation. c. CTE Nomenclature: When originally brought to Learning Council in early Fall 2024, a workgroup was created to flesh out the proposal and bring it back for a 2 nd review. At this 2 nd review,
