A	Current Proposal Requests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Library Extended Hours Student Wellness Rooms 	<p>Suggested to go back to the Library Extended hours sponsor with the following questions/concerns: Survey student needs and wishes – have students voiced the need for access to the library (potentially provide a QR code at library to survey.) Other concerns brought up to be addressed: would students be able to check out books and how would it work, would there be cameras in the library to monitor usage and potential issues, what is the risk/reward of keeping the space open, what is our current library usage/checkout rate. EGF said that they believe their current study spaces are being well utilized, and unsure of the need for extended library hours.</p> <p>Suggested to go back to the Student Wellness Room sponsor for clarification: EGF campus wanted more clarification on whether or not the current space used for prayer/meditation would be lost. They felt that it was necessary to have separate spaces as there were times in the past where students were needing to use the space for prayer or meditation at the same time a student would need it for lactation.
