8. Program Assessment	Linda	Linda is wondering what the status of Program Assessment is. Have there been some changes due to the pandemic? Division Chairs are supposed to give guidance to program faculty on program assessment. There has been some push-back from faculty on the assessment process. Because of the pandemic demands, the faculty have not had time to complete the required program assessment. Shamani indicated that the faculty should still complete the program assessment form and state on the form that, due to the pandemic, they are unable to get the results needed to complete the assessment. Justin indicated that some programs would have a lower graduation rates due to the pandemic. 5-year program assessment faculty should do what they can.
