## 1. FY12 Bonding Project

The Division Chairs discussed the list of items that need to be considered in the bonding project. Brian discussed the science labs and that the faculty would like to have all three together so that they course share chemicals. Beth mentioned that the Radiology Tech, Pharmacy Tech., Occupational Therapy Assistant, Early Childhood, and Respiratory Therapist program all have requests to revamp their areas. Pharmacy Tech would like to enlarge their space. The Cardiovascular program would like to see an update to their classroom also.

Dennis mentioned that the Welding Lab needs to be updated and that this was mentioned at the bonding meeting with the Division Chairs. Dennis also suggested that the Automotive program could go out to the Firefighter and Paramedic Program building. Then those programs along with carpentry could move to the main building.

Deb mentioned that the computer programs would like to be in close proximity to each other or even adjacent to each other. The server for the programs creates noise and it would make a difference if it is located in an enclosed space.

Dennis would like to see a secured area outside of the building for the Automotive program.

A concern was expressed by the Division Chairs if student life improvements were made at the cost of an existing program. A multipurpose room that would include aerobics, yoga, CPR, and music would be useful for the campus. The floor should be made of cork or wood and the room should be soundproof.
