Equipment Budget Requests (Perkins Funding Available)		There is Perkins funding in the amount of \$14,351.98 available to use towards equipment purchases. The committee's recommendations of the FY10 equipment budget requests were reviewed and it was decided that the top three Priority 1 requests be funded: • AD Nursing: Phlebotomy Arms \$2,800 • Auto Body Tech: Paint mixing Booth \$5,000 • PN: IV Pump \$3,000 Departments will prepare necessary purchase requests to encumber money and order equipment. It will then be decided what any remaining funds will be used towards.
