FY09 Projected Budget Report	Norma Konschak	The projected balanced budget for FY09 includes 7.1 million (instructional budget for TRF faculty). This takes into account the 7% increase in costs per the contract settlement. \$400,000 has been budgeted for equipment. This would be split \$130,000 per campus with \$140,000 for facility/administrative. There will be a 2% cut in overall spending. Tuition will be increased 2%. No new differential tuition fees/skills fees have been proposed with the exception of a possible increase for the aviation program.
Academic Groups-Task Group Report	Norma Konschak	Norma submitted a proposed division of academic groups for in-service work groups. The committee reviewed and approved. Attached to the minutes is a breakdown of the academic groups.

Summer Course Cancellation	Norma Konschak	Norma announced that enrollment for the summer classes scheduled to begin on May 19 th will be reviewed on Friday, May 9 th . The classes with low enrollment numbers will be reviewed for possible cancellation. Enrollment for the summer classes scheduled to begin June 2 nd will be reviewed on May 16 th .
