Online offerings seem to have taken the place of evening classes Mini-mester (8-week) classes Some of the Math courses have tried the 8-week format

Class Schedule for 2010-2011	Linda suggested that work on the schedule for 2010-2011 start earlier so that it can be finalized sooner to give students a chance to make their choices and have a chance to register earlier. The goal is to have a base schedule for fall and spring subject to additions as needed.
