Meeting Minutes

NAPE – Jeff, Katlyn, John, & 3 students attended the National Alliance for Partnerships in Equity Showcase, March 12-14 in Atlanta. Tasked with an action response project to work towards in one of 4 areas (making use of authentic student voice among those, creating systems of accountability for our equity work – the group originally chose to focus on both and then really honed in on making use of authentic student voice). The NAPE projects are intended to connect with Perkins V, Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment (CLNA) work, and while our group initially questioned how this NAPE involvement would tie into that CLNA work, it became clear that centering student voice was the real core of this work. Northland was the only group to have students involved from the outset – and to bring students to the Atlanta showcase. As students began to share, the project presented itself: student senate was not equitably representing student voice – on both campuses – and the students





wanted to address this. The group, post-conference wants to continue this project and ensure that the equity gaps in student senate – and thus centering student voice – continues on, making sure the work we're doing in DEI is bigger than any of us in this group. This brought the group to the realization that they'd like to recommend having this team develop a subcommittee to house the NAPE work in going forward.

Members were asked to consider who is missing at the table on this committee, and invite peers and students to join the group. Possibly, tasking each senate president with sitting on the Advancing Equity Committee.
