There might be alternative heat sources that can be used.
Healthy Campus outdoor Walking route	Jesse/Julie	Concerns about the outdoor walking route on the EGF campus were discussed. There is a section of the route that doesn't have sidewalks and employees would have to walk in the street. Bob Gooden is going to work with risk management as a first step to see what the college's liability is, and report back at the next meeting.
Door Locks – Severe Weather/Lockdown	Bob/Julie	An idea was brought forward to look into programming the electric locks for specific reasons. The doors on both campuses could be programed to be automatically locked during a lockdown and the shelter areas that could be locked could opened during severe weather. Tabled.
OSHA/MPCA Recommendations/Requ irements	Julie	OSHA/MPCA gives out requirements and recommendations. Do we want to just do what is required or go above and use the recommendation they give. It was discussed that this would go on case by case basis based on severity of the risk, cost to control, etc. Each requirement/recommendation would have the program/department heads brought in to discuss a solution.
